Kaiserslautern Applied and Industrial Mathematics Days – KLAIM with Focus on the Modeling, Simulation and Optimization of Digital Twins will take place in Kaiserslautern, Germany, from October 11-13, 2021.

- Multiscale Methods and Model Order Reduction with track plenaries giben by Francisco Chinesta (ENSAM Institute of Technology Paris), Nicole Marheineke (Universität Trier)
- 3. Integration of Optimization and Data Science with track plenary given by Alexander Martin (Friedrich-Alexander-Universität Erlangen-Nürnberg)
