

Dr. Stallforth began his career by studying mechanical engineering in Munich and law in Aachen, where he also completed his PhD. He then worked for over 30 years at Aesculap AG in Tuttlingen, serving as Head of Research and as a member of the executive board. He was intensively involved in the development of medical technology products and their use in surgical treatment.

In addition, he was also involved in numerous honorary positions at research institutions and in national and international standardization committees (e.g. DIN Committee for Precision Mechanics and Optics). In recognition of his remarkable career and his social engagement, Dr. Stallforth was awarded the Federal Cross of Merit last year.


